Red Ribbon Week:

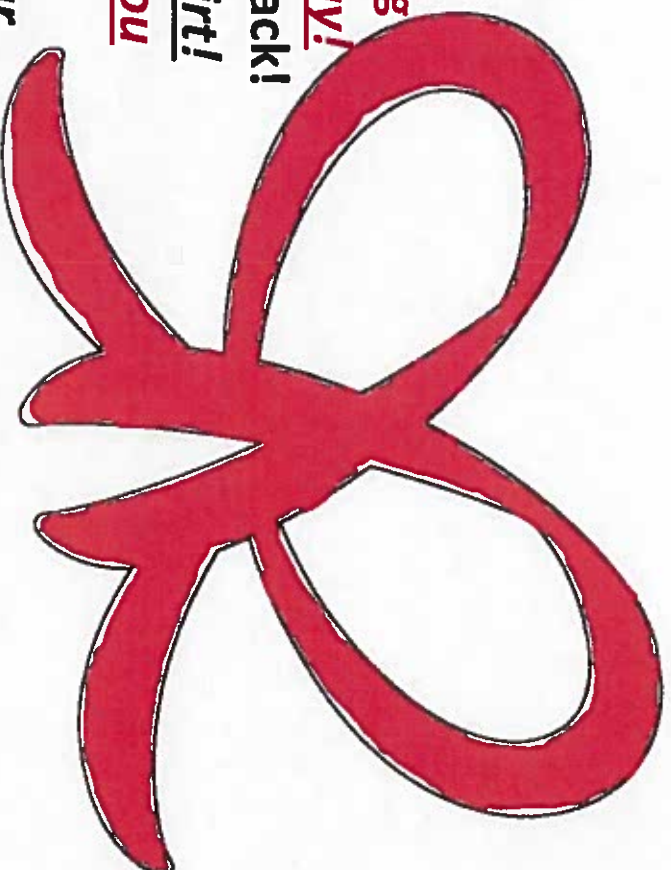
Monday: Wake up Drug Free! Wear your Pj's!

NO. Your trunk is your front door. You can decorate it as much (or as little) as you wish. If you are registering a vehicle, you must bring candy or something similar to hand out!

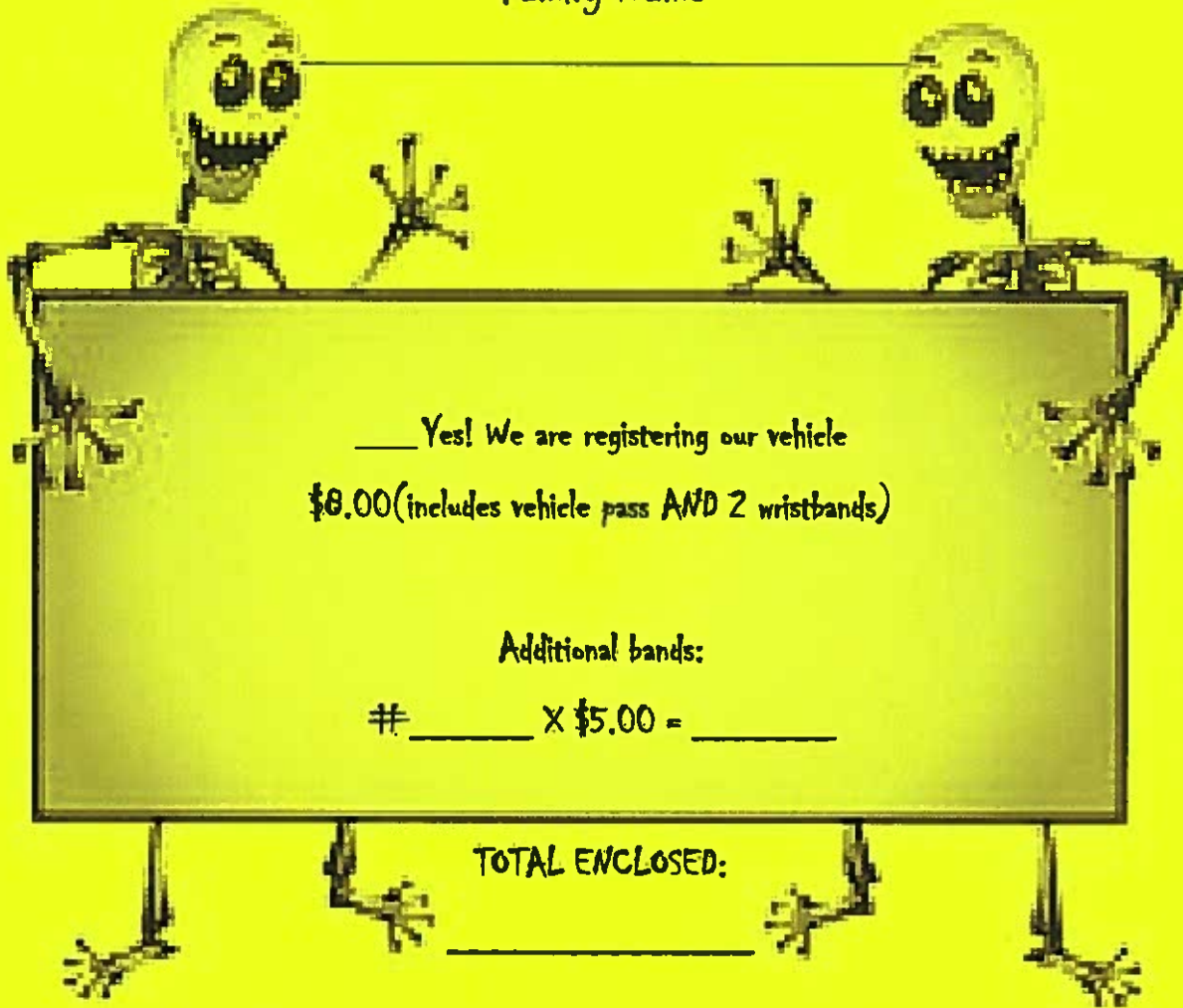
Invite your friends and family to join us for this event! We want to fill the lots and provide a fun night for all the kids!
