FAQs

When do I register for next year?

Come to Open House and bring a friend. If the friend pays the \$60 registration fee (and doesn't already attend SSRCS) and is going into K-7, then your registration fee is free!

How do I get ahold of someone in ASC?

If you are late picking your child up from an afterschool club or activity, s/he is sent into ASC (After School Care). If you run into traffic or are
