Grade 3: Canned vegetables or canned soup

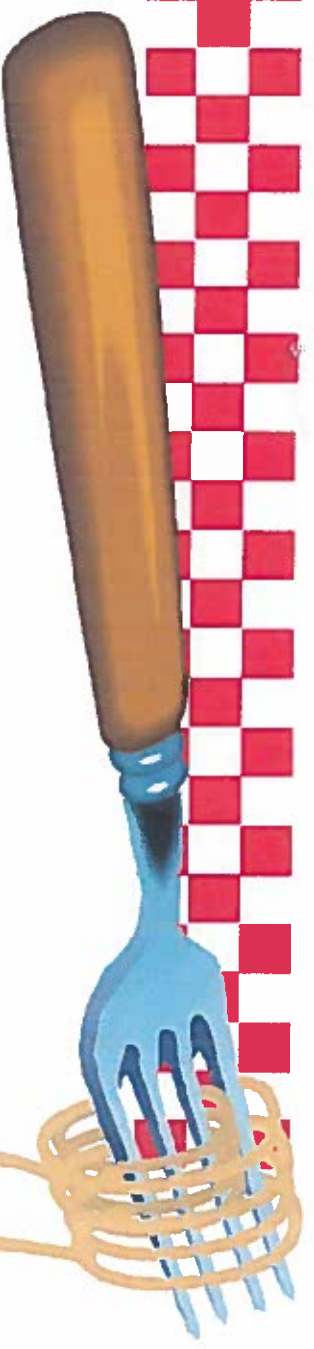
Grade 4: Canned vegetables or canned soup
