I would like to express my gratitude to all of you who have made me feel so welcome - Thank you! 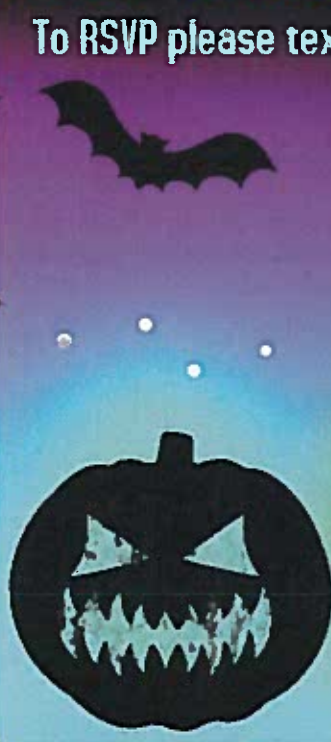
