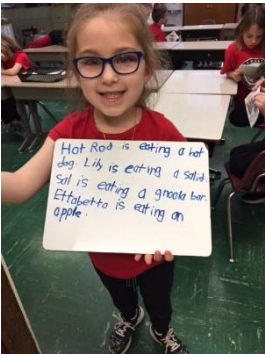


Can't stop dancing!
