and Tatum Lucero from Epiphany were confirmed by Bishop Malesic Thursday evening at St. Sebastian Parish. Congratulations!

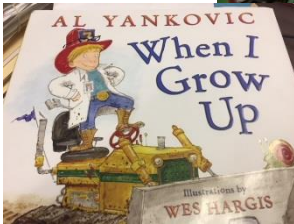
