Shoes (K-7)	 Black or Brown Dress Shoes with rubber bottoms, including "Sperry" style shoes. Boots are not to be worn in school. When boots are worn to school, shoes should be brought to change during inclement weather. Backless shoes, flip flops, slippers, or fur lined shoes are never permitted. Fluorescent colored shoes are not permitted. Shoes may not be heeled more than one inch. Wheeled or light up shoes are not permitted. High tops are NOT permitted. Dress down days	 Acrylic fingernails/tips should NOT be worn. Nail polish, if worn should be modest and light in color. No bright or fluorescent colors. Attire must be clean, neat, and modest; nothing tight, ripped, torn, or ragged may be worn. All shirts must have sleeves that cover the entire shoulder. No spaghetti straps, tank tops, midriff baring or open back shirts permitted. Jeans, sweatpants, and T shirts are permitted. T-shirts with inappropriate words and/or logos are not permitted. No Flipflops, heels or boots permitted. Only long shorts (no more than 3" above the knee) are permitted. 	 Attire must be clean, neat, and modest; nothing tight, ripped, torn, or ragged may be worn. Jeans, sweatpants, and T- shirts are permitted. T-shirts with inappropriate words and/or logos are not permitted. No Flipflops or boots permitted.
